The Five Year Old Physical

Vision focused on objects close at hand Centered on task Gross motor improving 3-fingered pincer grasp with pencil Falls out of chair sideways Paces self well

Social

Likes to help, cooperative, wants to be "good"
Likes rules and routines
Needs approval
Dependent on authority; wants to be told what to do, but also finds it difficult from another's viewpoint

Language

Literal, succinct
"Play" and "good" favorite words
Needs release from adult "Can I . . .?"
Fantasy more active, less verbal
Often does not communicate about school at home
Thinks out loud

Cognitive

Likes to copy
Literal behavior; often only one way to do things
Bound cognitively by sight and senses
Animistic (inanimate objects have life, movement)
Learns best through play and own action
Does not yet think logically
