



Phonemic Writing


Conventional/Some Phonemic Writing











Child draws a picture and uses 1 or more letters. Child writes strings of letters that convey a message. Some letters may not correspond to sounds. Child writes words and short sentences using letters (mostly consonants) to represent words and sounds. Child writes words using letters to represent most sounds that are heard. Consonants and vowels are used and there is some spacing between words. More readable sentences emerge. Child writes with independence and initiative. Use of more details and conventional structures, child uses classroom resources as tools for spelling. (word wall, books, charts)
